Terms and Conditions:

Proposals must be submitted in the prescribed "Proposal Outline". Submissions not using the prescribed outline will NOT be considered. Proposals may be submitted in writing via e-mail or by US mail postmarked on or before Friday, November 13, 2009. If attending all three days of the conference, presenters, who are not members of FLDOCA, are required to pay the expenses for the first two days (\$300) and if possible, supply their own computers. If a FLDOCA member and selected to speak, the registration fee for the full (3 days) conference will be \$245.00. If attending only the one day (day of presentation), the registration fee for the day (\$95.00) is waived. The call for proposals applies to Thursday, January 28, 2010, only. The review committee reserves the right to merge workshop and develop panels if necessary. Review committee selections are final.
